Hybrid Ministry that Makes Sense: The pandemic forced many churches to embrace online ministry very quickly and without the luxury of mindfulness. Now, as we begin integrating in-person worship with online ministries, we’re faced with creating a new normal. How will we integrate what we’ve learned about ministering to congregations online with what we already knew and loved about in-person ministries? In this course, Ryan Panzer, a church consultant, author, and public speaker on hybrid ministry, suggests effective ways to approach bringing online ministry and in-person ministry together. Ryan offers a basic philosophy for approaching hybrid ministry and suggests ways to balance building on- and offline communities as well as ways
